1. *size of the field of play*

Q6

- *The match is stopped*
- *The match is restarted by dropping the replacement ball at the place where the original ball became defective unless play was stopped inside the goal area , in which case the referee drops the replacement ball on the goal line at the point nearest to where the original ball was located when play was stopped.*

Q7

- *The referee must be informed before any proposed substitution is made*
- *The substitute only enters the field of play after the player being replaced has left and after receiving a signal from the referee*
- *The substitute only enters the field of play at the halfway line and during a stoppage in the match.*
- *The substitution is completed when a substitute enters the field of play*
- *From that moment the substitute becomes a player and the player he has replaced becomes a substituted player*
- *The substituted player takes no further part in the match*
- *All substitutes are subject to the authority and jurisdiction of the referee wether called upon to play or not*

### **Q8**

- *A jersey or shirt with sleeves if undergarments are worn the colour of the sleeve must be the same main colour as the sleeve of the jersey or shirt*
- *Shorts if undershorts are worn they must be of the same colour as the shorts*
- *Stockings*
- *Shinguards*
- *Footwear*

### **Q9**

- *The two teams must wear colours that distinguish them from each other and also the referee and the assistant referees*
- *Each goalkeeper must wear colours that distinguish him from the other players the referee and the assistant referees*

### **Q10**

- *Enforce the laws of the game*
- *Controls the match in co operation with his assistants and where applicable fourth official*
- *Ensures the ball meets requirement of Law 2*
- *Ensures that the players equipment meets requirements of law 4*
- *Acts as timekeeper and keeps a record of the match*
- *Stops suspends or abandons the match at his discretion for any infringement of the laws*
- *Stops suspends or abandons the match because of outside interference of any kind*
- *Stops the match if in his opinion a player is seriously injured and ensures that he is removed from the field of play. An injured player only returns to the field after the match has restarted.*
- *Allows play to continue until the ball is out of play if a player is in his opinion only slightly injured.*
- *Ensures that any player bleeding leaves the field of play and may only return on receiving a signal from the referee after bleeding has stopped.*
- *Allows play to continue when the team against which an offence has been committed will benefit from such an advantage and penalises the original offence if the anticipated advantage does not ensue at that time.*
- *Punishes the more serious offence, when a player commits more than one offence at the same time.*
- *Takes disciplinary action against players guilty of cautionable and sending off offences.*
- *Takes action against team officials who fail to conduct themselves in a responsible manner and may at his discretion expel them from the field of play and their surrounds.*
- *Acts on the advice of his assistants*
- *Ensures no unauthorised person enters the field of play*
- *Indicates the restart of the match after it has been stopped*
- *Provides the appropriate authorities with a match report*

### **Q11**

- *When the whole of the ball leaves the field of play*
- *When the team entitled to a corner kick/goal kick/ throw in*
- *When a player is penalised for being in an offside position*
- *When a substitution is required*
- *When misconduct or any other incident occurs out of the view of the referee*
- *When offences have been committed whenever the assistant referee has a better view than the referee*
- *Whether at penalty kicks, the goalkeeper moves off the goal line before the ball is kicked and if the ball crosses the line*
